NEW BUSINESS:

1. Hwy 8 Design Discussion

Mr. Triplett provided the City Council with an overview on the preliminary designs for Highway 8. Mr. Triplett highlighted potential pedestrian crossings, neighborhood impacts, and preliminary project costs.

Mr. Triplett also gave an update about the Roundabout and service road near Greenway Ave. and Greenway Lane. He stated that City Administrator Linwood and Engineer Erichson met with the property owners and neighbors to discuss the potential design. Mr. Triplett added that the county is currently working with their design engineer about potential tweaks and alternatives to the design.

The City Council inquired about safety, maintenance, ongoing costs, and timelines, among other things, relating to the project. The City Council thanked Mr. Triplett for attending the meeting and for his continued work on the designs.

2. 2024 Street Project Discussion

Mr. Erichson stated that WSB had completed its feasibility study on the proposed 2024 Street Project and that the report would be provided to the City Council at their May 7, 2024 Regular Meeting.

Mr. Erichson also said that there would be two different types of improvements, rural and urban, on the project and that the assessments may differ slightly because of this.

City Administrator Linwood informed the council that the city was still waiting to see the outcome with the bonding bill for funding of the public safety building. Mr. Linwood stated that this would be discussed at future meetings regarding bonding after May 20th. Staff is still recommending that the council receive the feasibility study for the 2024 street project at the May 7th, 2024 council meeting.
