Background Information:

As part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), the City received \$881,470.52. Over the past two years, staff has worked with the Council to identify appropriate expenditures for these funds. ARPA funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, or they will need to be returned to the U.S. Treasury. "Obligation" is defined as entering into a contract, agreement, or placing an order that requires payment.

To date, we have utilized the funds as follows:

- \$450,000 for the water main/sewer extension and sewer upsizing on the west side of the freeway.
- \$225,407.52 for ARMER radios for the Fire Department and Police Department.
- \$11,700 for fiber projects in the community
- \$150,000 for Water Meters

This leaves approximately \$44,363.00 in ARPA funds that still need to be allocated for use in 2024.

At a previous work session, a digital sign for the city was discussed as a potential option. Staff is seeking further direction from the council regarding whether to explore this option further or if there are other priorities they would like to consider for these remaining funds.



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
